STARTING UP BOTTLE PRODUCTION IN GREECE

Elopak Plastic Systems Hellas has recently started the production of blow-moulded HDPE new production plant in Thessalonica. After a short and intensive period of planning the factory for four months. It is situated on top of a hill, just a few kilometres from the highway leading from Athens.



Alkis Alexandrakis, Managing Director of Elopak Plastic Systems Hellas explains: "Our new factory is ideally situated in Thessalonica where the majority of our milk bottle production is based. It is sited close to one of South-East Europe's economic heart of a region with large growth potential. These are all strategic advantages for the factory. It will have the first ELOPAK plastic bottle factory in Greece."

Production of 500ml chocolate milk bottles has started on a new TECHNE extrusion blow moulding machine model 10000 SFA with a capacity of 2900 bottles/h. Two additional machines will be installed by the end of 2003 in order to ramp up production for the popular 500 and 1000 ml milk bottles demanded by DELTA Dairies. The new factory will also produce bottle closures. The first injection moulding machine for closures will be installed by the end of 2003.
